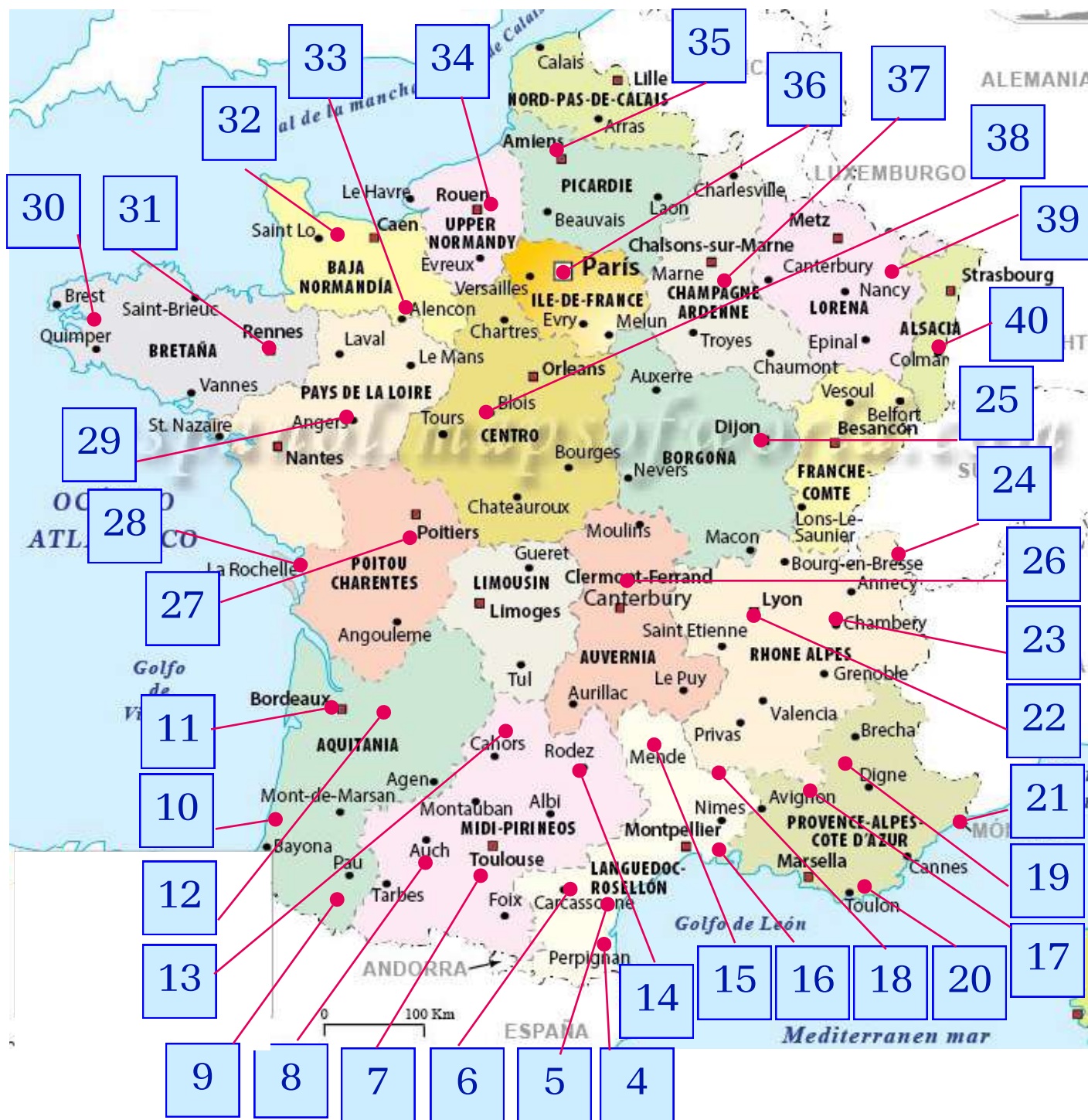
You have 3 places free of charge. So, for exemple, driver, tour leader and head of the group or Travel Agent manager don't have any extra charge.
